



CHÂTEAU OF CHÂTEAUDUN

Discover 4 centuries of history and architecture.

Sixty metres above the Loir river, the château of Jehan Dunois, known as the “Bastard of Orléans», contains a rare succession of medieval, Gothic and Renaissance architectural features. The Sainte-Chapelle is home to a remarkable collection of statues. The château also houses an important tapestry collection. The medieval hanging gardens, unique in the Centre region, offer an enjoyable place to relax during your visit.

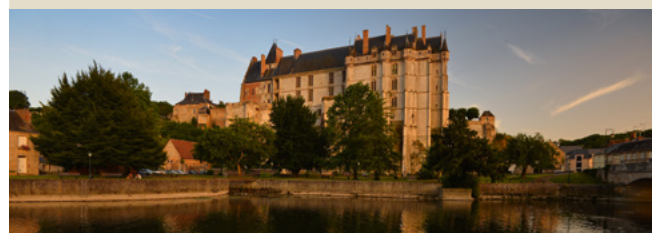
