



ABBAYE OF BEC-HELLOUIN

Spiritual centre of the Middle Ages and an architectural gem.

The majestic and peaceful Abbey of Notre-Dame-du-Bec stands in the heart of the Bec valley, on the banks of the narrow river that gives the site its name. The ancient Benedictine abbey, a jewel of Maurist architecture, Notre-Dame-du-Bec was founded in the 11th century, then reconstructed in the 17th and 18th centuries. You can visit the cloister, monastic buildings, the church and the gardens, then finish your visit by discovering the arts and crafts art produced by the monks who returned to the abbey in 1948!
