



SÈVRES JARDIES' HOUSE

Gambetta's house. Object bearing witness to an epoch.

This wine house was built on the southern slope of the Domaine de Saint-Cloud in the late 17th century. It belonged to novelist Honoré de Balzac, and subsequently became the property of Léon Gambetta, the founder of the Third Republic, who bought the house in 1878 and died here four years later. The Maison des Jardies has retained its original decor and today recalls the life and work of this great statesman and combative republican.

Main Road between Paris and Versailles, 7 km from Porte de Saint-Cloud

From Pont-de-Sèvres: N10 direction Versailles then Ville-d'Avray ; take at your right avenue Gambetta just before the road sign Ville-d'Avray

Bus: line 426 from the underground station Pont-de-Sèvres or line 469 from the Train Station of Sèvres Rive-gauche, and stop at: "Gare de Sèvres-Ville-d'Avray"
