

ABBEY OF MONTMAJOUR

The Abbey of Montmajour reveals 8 centuries of monastic life.

This outstanding architectural complex was built in the Middle Ages on the island of Mont Majour. The Abbey comprises a 10th century pre-Romanesque building, an abbey church and a 12th century Romanesque cloister built by the Benedictine monks. Montmajour was extended in the 18th century with a second monumental monastery to the west, the Saint Maur building. Its cloister was fully restored in 2013. The Saint Peter Hermitage, an 11th century cave church, is once again open to the public after several years of restoration work. The first floor of the Saint Maur building has also recently reopened.

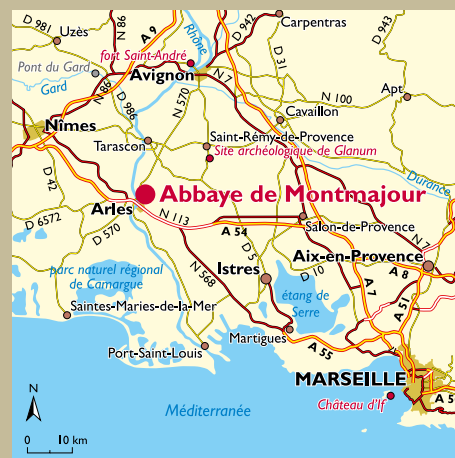
The cloister is accessible to people with reduced mobility
