



DUCAL CHÂTEAU OF CADILLAC

Along the Garonne 40 minutes from Bordeaux.

A captain of Gascony, the precursors to the Musketeers, the Duke of Epernon enjoyed a meteoric rise to power and built this château during the reigns of Henry IV and Louis XIII. This palace worthy of Kings combines splendour and military pomp. It still retains its monumental fireplaces, tapestries and painted ceilings... but became a women's prison in the 19th century. An extraordinary destiny.
